SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision 88139, dated November 22, 1977, the State of California, Department of Transportation (CALTRANS), was authorized to alter the existing grade separation on Interstate Route 80 at Highway Mileposts 1.9 and 2.8, inclusive, over the main line tracks of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company in the City of Richmond, Contra Costa County.

By letter of November 23, 1977, CALTRANS requested that the application be amended to permit a temporary impaired vertical clearance of not less than 21' 6" above top of rail during construction. By letter of December 6, 1977, the railroad stated that it had no objection to the proposed amendment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

1. Clearances shall be in accordance with General Order 26-D, except that during the period of construction a clearance of not less than 21' 6" above top of rail shall be authorized and The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company shall be authorized to operate with such reduced overhead clearance provided that instructions are issued by the railroad and filed with the Commission forbidding the employees to ride on tops of cars.
2. Applicant shall notify the Commission and The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company at least 15 but not more than 30 days in

advance of the date when the temporary impaired clearance will be created.

In all other respects, Decision 88139 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
