ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Southern California Edison Company coordinated the filing of this application with a joint petition of the California Air Resources Board and this Commission dated June 18, 1976 to the Federal Power Commission (FPC). In the joint petition a new statement of policy by the FPC was sought with respect to certification of pipeline transportation agreements for the transportation of natural gas obtained from intrastate producers or intrastate pipeline companies to be used, instead of fuel oil, as boiler fuel for the purpose of abating air pollution episodes in critical air basins. The Federal Power Commission has dismissed the joint petition.

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Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 56592 is dismissed.
