ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Applicant seeks a passenger stage corporation certificate authorizing the transportation of passengers and their baggage in mini buses between San Francisco hotels and the San Francisco International Airport. Public hearing was held before Administrative Law Judge Arthur M. Mooney in San Francisco on August 18, 1977. No evidence was taken, and the matter was continued to October 24 through 28, 1977 at the request of applicant's attorney.

By letter dated October 7, 1977, applicant's attorney requested that the matter be taken off calendar because of oppressive personal problems. Applicant's attorney was requested by our letter dated December 6, 1977 to advise if his client wished to proceed with this matter, and the letter informed him that if we did not hear from him within 15 days, the application would be scheduled for dismissal. No response to our letter having been received, the application will be dismissed.

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 57324 is dismissed.

The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the date hereof.
