SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision 86923, dated February 1, 1977, authorized the addition of grape stakes to the commodities in List C of Lumber and Forest Products in Item 685 of Minimum Rate Tariff 2 with an expiration date of September 1, 1977.

It has come to the Commission's attention that Decision 86923 does not reflect the intent of said decision in connection with the expiration date. The Commission intended to have said decision remain in effect until such time as the Commission came forth with a decision in Order Setting Hearing No. 771 in Case No. 5432.

Pursuant to Resolution A-4661,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff 2 (Appendix D to Decision 31606, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective thirty-nine days after the date hereof, Sixteenth Revised Page 51-C, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
2. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act, to the extent that they are subject also to Decision 31606, as amended, are authorized to establish in their tariffs the amendment necessary to conform with the further adjustment ordered by this decision.
3. Tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of this order may be made effective not earlier than thirty-nine days after the date hereof and may be made effective on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public.


if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff page incorporated in this order.

4. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the amendment authorized by this order, are authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 461.5 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the amendment published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders.

5. In all other respects, Decision 31606, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order is thirty days after the date hereof.
