OPINION AND ORDER

By this application, Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent (WMTB) seeks authority to delete certain commodity rates in WMTB Local, Joint and Proportional Freight and Express Tariff No. 111, Cal. P.U.C. No. 15 (WMTB 111).<sup>1</sup>

Applicant states that Peters Truck Lines (PTLY) wishes to cancel these rates to obtain tariff simplification since no traffic has moved at these rates for a period of three years. Should new traffic appear, PTLY intends to apply class rates published in WMTB 111.

Because of the absence of any traffic being transported of these commodities, cancellation of the items will result in no change in the carrier's revenue.

The application was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of February 16, 1978. No objection to the granting of the application has been received.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that the cancellation of the items, as proposed, is justified. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the application should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, is hereby authorized, on behalf of Peters Truck Lines, to delete in its Local, Joint and Proportional Freight and Express Tariff No. 111, Cal. P.U.C. No. 15, the items specifically described in the application.

2. Tariff publications authorized to be made as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

3. The authority herein granted shall expire unless exercised within ninety days after the effective date of this order.

This order shall become effective thirty days after the date hereof.
