ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This application was originally scheduled for hearing on August 15, 1977. It was continued to August 26, 1977 and was taken off calendar on August 23. At the request of counsel, who advised he could no longer represent applicant due to a conflict, since a protest was filed by another client, letters were mailed to applicant on October 13, 1977 and October 28, 1977 to ask whether the matter should be scheduled for hearing. Applicant telephoned in October to advise that he was in the process of hiring another attorney. There has been no other communication from applicant. A letter was sent to applicant on

January 31, 1978 advising him that the matter was scheduled for dismissal unless he was prepared to go to hearing. Applicant has failed to contact the Commission; the application should be dismissed.
