OPINION AND ORDER

By this application, American Transfer Co., requests authority to deviate from the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff 2 in connection with the transportation of glass, flat, not bent for Guardian Industries Corporation from Kingsburg to Los Angeles.¹

Applicant cites the following special circumstances and conditions: (1) shipments are to be power loaded and unloaded without expense to the carrier; (2) anticipated volume is five truck-loads per day.

Revenue and expense data submitted by applicant indicate that the transportation involved may reasonably be expected to be profitable under the proposed rates.

The application was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of February 15, 1978. No protest to the granting of the application has been received in the form prescribed by Rule 42.2 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant's proposal is reasonable. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the application should be granted as set

forth in the ensuing order and the effective date of this order should be the date hereof because there is an immediate need for this rate relief.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. American Transfer Co. is authorized to perform the transportation shown in Appendix A attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof at not less than the rates set forth therein.

2. The authority granted herein shall expire one year after the effective date of this order unless sooner cancelled, modified or extended by further order of the Commission.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.

APPENDIX A

Carrier: American Transfer Co.
Commodity: Glass, flat, not bent, not exceeding 15 feet in length or 9 feet in width.
For: Guardian Industries Corporation
From: Kingsburg
To: Metropolitan Zones 201-262
Rate: 68 cents per 100 pounds
Minimum Weight: 50,000 pounds

Conditions:

1. Shipments shall be power loaded and power unloaded without expense to the carrier.
2. Applicant has not indicated that subhaulers will be engaged nor have any costs of subhaulers been submitted. Therefore, if subhaulers are employed they shall be paid no less than the rates authorized herein without any deduction for use of applicant's trailing equipment.
3. In all other respects the rates and rules in Minimum Rate Tariff 2 shall apply.
