OPINION AND ORDER

By this application, Daniel Edward Vaughn, requests an extension of his current authority to deviate from the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff 2 in connection with the transportation of lumber and forest products for Far West Fir Sales Company between various California points as authorized by Decision 87006, dated February 23, 1977.

This authority was scheduled to expire on February 22, 1978 but was extended by Special Deviation Docket No. SDD-731 on February 24, 1978 making this application moot, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Application 57802 is dismissed without prejudice.

This order is issued pursuant to Section 308 of the Public Utilities Code and Resolution A-4638.
