SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

It has come to the Commission's attention that Decision 88683 does not reflect the intent of said decision with respect to the application of surcharges to canned goods rates.

Pursuant to Resolution A-4661,

IT IS ORDERED that:


1. Minimum Rate Tariff 2 (Appendix D to Decision 31606, as amended), is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective May 13, 1978, First Revised Page 47.1, First Revised Page 47.2, First Revised Page 47.3 and First Revised Page 47.7 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. Tariff publications of common carriers shall be made effective not earlier than May 13, 1978 on one day's notice to the Commission and to the public.

3. In all other respects Decision 88683, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
