O P I N I O N

Applicant Edith Jacobsen requested that she receive a variance from Decision No. 86193, so that she may receive water service to her home project, now under construction, and for which a sewer connection has already been installed.

Ordering Paragraph 3 of Decision No. 86193, an Interim Order in Case No. 10093, provides as follows:

"3. Respondent shall make no new connections until such time as it can demonstrate a sufficient water supply to provide for additional customers without adversely affecting service to existing customers. Respondent shall exempt therefrom all applicants for service having a building permit issued prior to August 3, 1976."

On March 21, 1978, subsequent to the filing of this application, the Commission issued Decision No. 88618 in Case No. 10093. That decision, which was effective on the date issued, by Ordering Paragraph No. 2 modifies the ban on new water service connection as follows:

"On and after the effective date of this order, applicants for water service having a valid sewer permit may be connected to the Montara District water system of Citizens Utilities Company of California."

Applicant has installed a sewer under a valid sewer permit and thus may receive water service upon making appropriate request therefore to Citizens Utilities Company of California, Montara District.

The Commission concludes that the application should be dismissed.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that the application is dismissed.

The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the date hereof.
