ORDER GRANTING RENEWAL OF SUSPENSION OF SERVICE

Pacific Southwest Airlines (PSA) requested a suspension of service between San Diego (SAN) and Ontario (ONT) for a period of 90 days, beginning January 4, 1978, to be granted on an ex parte basis. During this 90-day period, PSA intended to monitor public response to the suspension, review its operational procedures and consider requesting a renewal of the suspension per Section 2766, or discontinuance of the SAN-ONT service per Section 2769.5 of the Passenger Air Carriers Act.

The suspension was granted in Decision No. 88350, effective January 17, 1978.

In a letter dated March 23, 1978, PSA requests a renewal of the suspension so that it can extend its review of public reaction and economic effects into the summer quarter. PSA states that it has not received complaints or other evidence of negative public reaction and has not found operating losses due to the suspension of service in this segment.

The request for the extension of the suspension is reasonable in light of the results for the first quarter of the year.

IT IS ORDERED that:

Pacific Southwest Airlines be authorized to continue its suspension of passenger air service between San Diego and Ontario, pursuant to Section 2766 of the Public Utilities Code, for a period of ninety days beginning April 17, 1978.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
