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SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision 88633 dated March 21, 1978 in this proceeding, granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity as a cement carrier to Fairburn Transportation, Inc. The certificate authorizes the transportation of cement from any and all points of origin to all points in the counties of Fresno, Kern, Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino, San Diego and Ventura. It has been brought to the attention of the Commission's staff that authority for the transportation of cement to and within the counties of Inyo, San Luis Obispo and Santa Barbara, was inadvertantly omitted from the Appendix A of Decision 88633.

In the circumstances it appears that the necessary correction should be made by the order herein and the Appendix A of Decision 98633 should be amended accordingly. The effective date of the order should be the date on which it is signed since there is no known opposition and no reason to delay correcting the discrepancy.

IT IS ORDERED that Decision 88633 is amended by substituting the attached First Revised Page 1 of Appendix A in place and instead of Original Page 1.
