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Decision No. 12882

APPLICANT TO STATE AND FEDERAL UTILITIES COMMISSIONS AND OTHERS

4. Applicant does not request an exemption from Section 1001 with respect to construction within California to which the section would be otherwise applicable.

5. Applicant has no thermal electric generation plant in California.

6. Applicant is participating with other utilities in steam plants under construction or in the siting stages in Oregon, Montana, Washington, and Wyoming.

Conclusion

The requested exemption should be granted for a period of three years.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that until June 15, 1981, Pacific Power & Light Company is exempted from Public Utilities Code Section 1001 with respect to all lines, plants, or systems which applicant may construct outside the State of California to which Section 1001 would otherwise be deemed to apply. This exemption does not apply to any lines, plants, or systems which applicant may construct within California. ✓
