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ORDER CONTINUING SUSPENSION OF DECISION NO. 88551

On March 7, 1978, we issued Decision No. 88551 in this proceeding and, inter alia, ordered the respondent gas and electrical corporations to implement a program of financial assistance for residential attic insulation within 60 days from the effective date of that Decision.

During the period from March 24th through April 5, 1978, petitions for rehearing of Decision No. 88551 were filed by nine parties. Some of these were filed in time to suspend the Decision pursuant to provisions of Section 1733(a) of the Public Utilities Code. That suspension will terminate on May 23, 1978 unless, by that date, we have acted to grant or deny such petitions or to extend the suspension.

We are carefully considering each and every allegation of error in these petitions to determine whether good cause for rehearing has been shown. We believe it proper to extend the suspension now in effect until we reach a decision on the merits, if any, of these allegations. Therefore,

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IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 88551 is hereby suspended until further order of this Commission.
