ORDER REVOKING PRIOR CERTIFICATE

By Decision No. 85611 the Commission granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity authorizing home-to-work bus operations to and from the Hughes Aircraft Company, El Segundo, for employees residing in Garden Grove, Los Alamitos, Bellflower, and adjacent communities. Decision 88064 provided for suspension of this certificate for a period not to exceed April 1, 1978. It further provided for the automatic lapse of the authority if service was not reinstated by April 1, 1978.

By telephone conversation with Mr. Kadletz on March 28, 1978, confirmed by letter from Mr. Kadletz dated March 29, our staff learned that he was no longer operating the suspended commuter route and that he understood it would be revoked.

IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation, authorized by Decision 85611 in Application 55921 and suspended by Decision 88064, is hereby revoked and pertinent tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission are canceled upon the effective date of this order.

The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the date hereof.
