ORDER OF DISMISSAL

The County of Los Angeles seeks authority to construct the Ballona Creek Bicycle Path at grade across the Southern Pacific Transportation Company's Inglewood Branch Line at Milepost BBE-498.48 in the vicinity of Marina Del Rey, Los Angeles County. By letter of May 4, 1978, the Southern Pacific Transportation Company has advised that its Inglewood Branch Line was officially abandoned on January 5, 1978, between Mileposts 498.112 and 502.200. Commission authority is, therefore, no longer required for construction of the Ballona Creek Bicycle Path across the railroad's right-of-way.

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 56893 is dismissed.

This order is issued pursuant to Section 308 of the Public Utilities Code and Resolution No. A-4638.

The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the date hereof.
