SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 88895 entered today in Case No. 5432 (Order Setting Hearing 965) et al., the Commission concluded that the transportation of empty sea vans and flattened automobile bodies should be exempted from the minimum rates named in Minimum Rate Tariffs 2, 1-B, 9-B, and 19.

The Commission further concluded in said decision that Minimum Rate Tariffs 1-B and 19 should be amended by separate order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff 1-B (Appendix B of Decision No. 65834 as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective thirty-nine days after the date hereof, Nineteenth Revised Page 14 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. Minimum Rate Tariff 19 (Appendix A of Decision No. 41363, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective thirty-nine days after the date hereof, Eighteenth Revised Page 15-A attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

3. In all other respects Decisions Nos. 41363 and 65834, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the date hereof.
