ORDER GRANTING RENEWAL OF SUSPENSION OF SERVICE

Swift Aire Lines, Inc. in Decision 83528 was granted authority to suspend service over Route 7 (San Francisco-Modesto-Fresno) for a period of ninety days beginning March 5, 1978.

In a letter to the Commission, dated May 9, 1978, the applicant requested that an additional ninety days be added to its current suspension scheduled to expire June 3, 1978. Swift Aire requests the renewal in order to further evaluate the need and economic feasibility of providing air service to Modesto.

Swift Aire is hereby notified that no further extension will be granted. If Swift Aire is not going to provide air passenger service between San Francisco-Modesto-Fresno, its certificate should be amended to delete this operating authority. The certificates of passenger air carriers should reflect and contain only the authority operated, and should not reflect dormant or essentially abandoned authority.

IT IS ORDERED that:

Swift Aire Lines, Inc. be authorized to suspend passenger air service at Modesto pursuant to Section 2766 of the Public Utilities Code, for a period of ninety days, effective June 3, 1978.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
