## ORDER CORRECTING OMISSION

The Commission, by Decision No. 88536 dated March 7, 1978 in this proceeding, authorized William and Delia Hay, doing business as Point Arena Water Works, to borrow funds in an amount not to exceed \$150,000 and execute notes therefor to the U.S. Small Business Administration. The decision, however, omitted the fee prescribed by Section 1904(b) of the Public Utilities Code.

Applicant's attorney has informed the staff that the notes have been issued.

Pursuant to Resolution No. A-4661,

IT IS ORDERED that the omission is corrected as follows:

Applicants shall, within thirty days from the effective date hereof, pay the fee prescribed by Section 1904(b) of the Public Utilities Code, which fee is \$300.
