

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Decision No. <u>89015</u>, entered today in Case No. 5432 (Petition 1007) et al., found that the parcel rates in Minimum Rate Tariffs 1-B and 19 should be canceled and that amendment of the tariffs ould be accomplished by separate order.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff 1-B (Appendix B of Decision No. 65834, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective thirty-nine days after the date hereof, Twelfth Revised Page 6 and Twentyfirst Revised Page 43 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. Minimum Rate Tariff 19 (Appendix A of Decision No. 41363, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective thirty-nine days after the date hereof, Thirty-second Revised Page 40, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

3. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act, to the extent that they are subject to Decisions Nos. 65834 and 41363, as amended, are hereby authorized to establish in their tariffs the revisions necessary to conform with the further adjustments ordered herein.

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4. Tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers • a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order, on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order.

5. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the amendments authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 461.5 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations, such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order, and schedules containing the amendments published under this authority shall make reference to the prior order authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

6. In all other respects Decisions Nos. 65834 and 41363, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the date hereof.


