By Decision No. 88597, issued on March 21, 1978, the Commission ordered the filing of tariffs by the Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, General Telephone Company of California and Continental Telephone Company of California which prescribed a definition of nonpublished service, specified agencies to receive nonpublished information and credit information, and, among other things, provided a procedure for the release of such information. Thereafter, the Commission has received many petitions for rehearing and modification of said decision and has received a barrage of letters and telephone requests from federal, state and local agencies to be included as agencies designated to receive nonpublished information.

Decision No. 88597 provided an effective date of thirty days from March 21, 1978. By a timely filed petition for rehearing, the said Decision was stayed for a period of 60 days, which time period has now expired. Since the Commission has continued to receive almost daily requests for inclusion among the agencies designated to receive nonpublished information, it is appropriate that the effective date of Decision No. 88597 be further stayed pending a determination of the nature and time of further proceedings. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the effective date of Decision No. 88597 is stayed until further order of the Commission.
