OPINION

This complaint was filed on May 26, 1977. It consisted of two paragraphs and requested that defendant be ordered to do whatever is necessary to improve the water situation. No answer or other pleading was filed by defendant and a staff engineer interviewed customers of the system and submitted a report. The complaint was never amended, although a notice was mailed to advise complainants that their pleading failed to state a cause of action.

The staff engineer filed a report dated September 20, 1977 and several letters were subsequently received which praised the water quality and supply. Several other letters inquired whether a hearing would be scheduled. No letters have been received since December 1977 and there has been no reply to a Commission letter dated April 5, 1978 which warned that the complaint does not state a cause of action and will be dismissed in May 1978 unless it is amended and someone writes to request that a hearing be scheduled.

This complaint is too brief and too broad to provide a basis for the Commission to afford relief. If problems exist. those who are affected can request that the Commission institute a formal investigation of the defendant water company.

We find and conclude that the complaint should be dismissed for failure to state a cause of action.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Case No. 10338 is dismissed. The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the date hereof. San Francisco California, this 1/th-Dated at JULY day of
