SECOND ORDER EXTENDING TIME

In Decision No. 87746, entered on August 23, 1977, the Commission authorized Victor Radio Telephone Corporation, a California corporation, to issue and sell 800 shares of its common capital stock to John K. Passeneau and Frederick Daniel, and authorized Martin E. Willson, dba Victor Valley Radio-Telephone Company, a public utility radiotelephone business, to sell and transfer to Victor Radio Telephone Corporation all of his radiotelephone operating rights, properties, and equipment for \$12,000. Decision No. 87746, which was effective on the date it was issued, provided that the transfer of Willson's radio-telephone operating rights and properties should be made within 120 days after August 23, 1977 (on or before December 21, 1977). The decision also provided that the issuance of said 800 common capital shares of Victor Radio Telephone Corporation should be accomplished on or before January 31, 1978.

On November 23, 1977 the parties in Application No. 55888 entered into an agreement relating to the operating rights with Industrial Communications Systems, Inc. On January 16, 1978 these parties filed Application No. 57811 in connection with the November 23rd agreement. On January 17, 1978 the Commission in Decision No. 88342 extended the time in which to comply with Decision No. 87746 until June 30, 1978.

Applicant seeks an additional extension of time to comply with Decision No. 87746 because Application No. 57811 is still pending. In the circumstances the Commission finds that the extension is warranted.

IT IS ORDERED that the time in which the parties may have to comply with the provisions of Decision No. 87746 is hereby extended until thirty days after the effective date of the decision which the Commission enters in Application No. 57811.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
