OPINION AND ORDER

By this petition, E. L. Yeager Construction Co., Inc., seeks modification of Section 3 of Minimum Rate Tariff 17-A (MRT 17-A). MRT 17-A names minimum rates for the transportation of property in dump truck equipment from defined production areas to designated delivery zones and points in Southern California. Section 3 of the tariff names specific delivery points for application of Area-to-Point rates.

Petitioner is in the business of manufacturing, marketing and distributing rock, sand and gravel products and seeks to include its plant as a named delivery point within Section 3. This modification is sought in order to be more competitive with other contractors in the Riverside area who do not have to import raw materials required for asphaltic concrete products. If granted, the petitioner would be entitled to a rate reduction of 3¢ per ton from applicable zone rates.

A staff field survey has determined that the petitioner's plant conforms to the delivery point criteria established by Decision 57675, dated December 2, 1958 and Decision 80810, dated December 12, 1972 in Case 5437.

Copies of the petition were served on various known carriers and shipper organizations and other parties on or about May 2, 1978. The petition was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of May 10, 1978. No objection to the granting of the petition has been received.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that the establishment of an additional delivery point as hereinafter provided will result in just, reasonable and nondiscriminatory minimum rates for the transportation involved. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the petition should be granted as indicated in the ensuing order.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff 17-A (Appendix C of Decision 80578, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective thirty-nine days after the date hereof, Seventh Revised Page 3-5 and Seventh Revised Page 3-6, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act to the extent that they are subject to Decision 80578, as amended, are authorized to establish in their tariffs the amendments necessary to conform with the further adjustments ordered herein.

3. Tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of this order may be made effective not earlier than thirty-nine days after the date hereof and may be made effective on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order.

4. Common carriers in establishing and maintaining the amendments authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 461.5 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the amendments published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

5. In all other respects Decision 80578, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
