ORDER DENYING REHEARING OF DECISION NO. 88640

A petition for rehearing of Decision No. 88640 has been filed by the City of Los Angeles. The Commission has considered said petition and is of the opinion that no good cause for rehearing has been made to appear.

The City of Los Angeles is an intervenor in this proceeding. As such, it was entitled to timely notice of all acts done by the Atlantic Richfield Company and its subsidiary, the Four Corners Pipeline Company, pursuant to Decision No. 88640. It appears that the City of Los Angeles did not receive notice of the filing of tariffs by the Four Corners Pipeline Company until the statutory 30-day period for filing protests to such tariffs had nearly expired, thus effectively precluding the City from registering a protest, should it have desired to do so. We are of the opinion that the City should be given a reasonable period of time to inspect these tariffs, to file a protest, and request a hearing if it so chooses. The tariffs now on file with the Commission will remain in effect.

IT IS ORDERED that rehearing of Decision No. 88640 is hereby denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

The Executive Director shall immediately cause personal service to be made on the City of Los Angeles of a copy of the tariffs filed with the Commission by the Four Corners Pipeline Company.

The City of Los Angeles shall have 15 days from the date of service of said tariffs to review them and file with the Commission a protest and request for hearing.

The tariffs now on file with the Commission will remain in effect. The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
