SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION & ORDER

It has come to the Commission's attention that Decision No. 89178 does not reflect the intent of such decision with respect to the total allotment of water per household in the emergency rationing plan. Further, the decision inadvertently failed to specify the effective date the rationing plan as well as date for the owner/operator to file a tariff with the Commission.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Each consumer shall be allotted 200 gallons per household per day.

2. The effective date of the rationing plan shall be August 11, 1978.

3. The owner/operator of the system shall file with the Commission an Advice Letter with a tariff delineating the rationing plan postmarked no later than August 18, 1978.

4. In all other respects Decision No. 89178, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
