ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Public hearing of Application No. 57742 was held before
Administrative Law Judge Gagnon at San Francisco on April 27, 1978
at which time the matter was taken off calendar in order to afford
Local Parcel Service, Inc. (applicant) an opportunity to seek an
alternate form of relief. By Commission's Order No. SDD-769, issued
June 13, 1978, applicant was authorized to transport packages
weighing 100 pounds or less at rates less or different than the
otherwise governing minimum rates, subject to an expiration date of
December 6, 1978. Since the authority granted by Commission Order
No. SDD-769 is substantially the same as originally sought in
Application No. 57742, said application is now moot.

Upon applicant's request after hearing,
IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 57742 is dismissed.
The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after
the date hereof.
