SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

On June 16, 1978, applicant, Pacific Power & Light Company, filed a Petition for Modification of Decision No. 88831, dated May 16, 1978.

Decision No. 88831 granted applicant's request for an exemption from Public Utilities Code Section 1001 for out-of-state construction for a period of three years. Applicant alleges that the decision is ambiguous in regard to plant which may be under construction when the exemption period expires. We conclude that Decision No. 88831 should be modified to set forth, without ambiguity, the exemption we have granted.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Decision No. 88831 is amended by adding the following sentence to the order:

This exemption is applicable to all construction commenced outside the State of California before June 15, 1981.

2. In all other respects Decision No. 88831 remains in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the date hereof.
