The City of Lafayette has filed a petition for rehearing of Decision No. 88890. The Commission has considered each and every allegation therein and is of the opinion that no good cause for granting the requested relief has been shown; however, having been advised in a letter from the Metropolitan Transportation Commission that adequate alternative commute service may not be available by October 2, 1978, the date Greyhound Lines, Inc. was authorized to discontinue its midweek commute service between Contra Costa County and San Francisco, we will reopen these proceedings for a one day hearing to hear evidence on the question of whether the October 2, 1978 date should be extended. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the petition for rehearing is denied but that the proceedings are hereby reopened for purposes of hearing evidence on the question of whether the October 2, 1978 date, the date Greyhound Lines, Inc. was authorized to discontinue its midweek commute service between Contra Costa County and San Francisco, should be extended. Said hearing shall be held at 9:30 a.m. on Monday, September 11, 1978, in the Commission Courtroom, State Building, San Francisco, before Administrative Law Judge Thomas Daly.
