Applicant requested domestic water service from California-American Water Company, Monterey District, as a variance from the water service moratorium imposed by Ordering Paragraph 4 of the Commission's Decision No. 84527, dated June 10, 1975, in Case No. 9530.

This Commission, by Ordering Paragraph 1.d. of Decision No. 89195, dated August 8, 1978, in Case No. 9530, rescinded Ordering Paragraph 4 of Decision No. 84527, effective September 8, 1978.

Applicant may now receive domestic water service after September 8, 1978, upon proper application to the California-American Water Company. The application is therefore moot and should be dismissed.
