THIRD ORDER EXTENDING TIME

The Commission has twice extended the time in which the parties may have to comply with the provisions of Decision No. 87746, which authorized the sale of radiotelephone utility operating rights, properties, and equipment. It also authorized the issuance of stock. The verified petition avers that the sale cannot be consummated without the approval of the FCC; that an application is pending before the FCC; and that approval could not be obtained before the Commission's second extension of time expired on September 9, 1978. A further extension is requested. In the circumstances, the Commission finds that the extension is warranted and that the order granting it should be effective on the date of issuance.

IT IS ORDERED that the time in which the parties may have to comply with the provisions of Decision No. 87746 is hereby extended until December 29, 1979.
