CORRECTING OPINION AND ORDER

In Decision No. 88651, dated April 4, 1978, Additional Finding 13 contains an error in that Cal-Pacific (now CP National) is listed with those utilities whose service areas include second homes which should be accorded lifeline volumes and quantities and whose revenues would not be adversely affected by resulting conservation. For gas service, Cal-Pacific (now CP National) should be included, as it has been, with those utilities for which lifeline allowances for second homes should not be provided in rate structure.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 88651, dated April 4, 1978, is amended by deleting therefrom the utility name "Cal-Pacific" in the last sentence of Additional Finding 13, page 22 (mimeo.).
