ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision 62290 as amended by Decision 72092 in Application No. 43492, California Medical Missionary and Benevolent Association, doing business as The Howell Mountain Bus Line, was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation to transport passengers and their baggage between St. Helena and Sanitarium and intermediate points.

By letter dated April 18, 1978, the carrier said it discontinued passenger service on June 30, 1977 because of insurance premium costs.

It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforementioned certificate and that such revocation would not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked and that tariffs and timetables applicable to the service thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation authorized by Decisions 62290 and 72092 in Application 43492 is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of The California Medical Missionary and Benevolent Association doing business as The Howell Mountain Bus Line are canceled upon the effective date of this order.

The Executive Director shall mail a certified copy of this order to The California Medical Missionary and Benevolent Association, care of St. Helena Hospital and Health Center, Deer Park, CA 94576, last known address as shown on the Commission's records.
