ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision 85458, dated February 18, 1976, in Application 55793, William Royal, Ken Lewis, Dean Feerandini and Robert Kenyon, doing business as The Confluence, were granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation to transport passengers and their rafts, kayaks and other boating equipment between The Confluence (located near Vallecito), Melones Camp, Parrots Ferry Bridge and Camp 9 Powerhouse located on or near the Stanislaus River daily during the months of April and September of each year.

The carrier, by Commission Resolution PE-344, dated January 11, 1977, was placed under voluntary suspension until June 1, 1977.

The carrier has had no evidence on file with this Commission showing adequate protection against liability imposed by law for payment of damage for personal injury or property damage, as required by General Order 101-C since September 1, 1976.

On April 3, 1978 the Commission staff sent a registered letter to the carrier advising it that the staff will recommend to the Commission to revoke its authority unless it filed a Certificate of Insurance in accordance with General Order 101-C or submitted in writing a valid explanation why it is not exercising the authority. The Commission has not received a Certificate of Insurance or any written information from the carrier.

It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforenamed certificate and that such revocation would not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked and that tariffs and timetables applicable to the service thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation, authorized by Decision 85458 in Application 55793, is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of William Royal, Ken Lewis, Dean Feerandini and Robert Kenyon, doing business as The Confluence, are canceled upon the effective date of this order.
