OPINION AND ORDER

By this application, Bulk Transportation (Bulk), a corporation, requests authority to deviate from the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff 7-A in connection with the transportation of limestone for Kerr Glass Manufacturing Corporation from Lucerne Valley to Santa Ana.

According to applicant, the following special circumstances prevail: (1) The involved transportation is a large volume movement, (2) the facilities for loading and unloading are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week, and (3) transportation can be coordinated with other movements by Bulk which terminate near Lucerne Valley.

Revenue and expense data submitted by applicant indicate that the transportation involved may reasonably be expected to be profitable under the proposed rates.

The application was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of August 11, 1978. No objection to the granting of the application has been received.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant's proposal is reasonable. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the application should be granted as set forth in the ensuing order and the effective date of this order should be the date hereof because there is an immediate need for this rate relief.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Bulk Transportation is authorized to perform the transportation shown in Appendix A attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof at not less than the rate set forth therein.

2. The authority granted herein shall expire one year after the effective date of this order unless sooner cancelled, modified, or extended by further order of the Commission.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.

APPENDIX A

Carrier: Bulk Transportation
Shipper: Kerr Glass Manufacturing Corporation
Commodity: Limestone
From: Charles Pfizer Company Plant, Lucerne Valley
To: Kerr Glass Manufacturing Corporation, Santa Ana
Rate: \$6.00 per ton, 26 tons minimum weight

Conditions:

1. Loading and unloading time in excess of one hour to be charged at the rate of \$4.20 for each 15 minutes or fraction thereof.
2. Applicant has indicated that subhaulers will not be engaged. If subhaulers are employed, they shall be paid no less than the rate authorized herein without any deduction for use of applicant's trailing equipment.
3. In all other respects, the rates and rules in Minimum Rate Tariff 7-A shall apply.
