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By Decision 84212 aated March 18, 1975, in Application 54362, Smith Transportation Co., a Califormia corporation, was granted a certificate of pubiic convenience and necessity to transport general commodities over a number of routes located in an area bounded on the northeast by the City of Madera, on the nortinwest by the City of Paso Robles, on the south by the City of Ios Angeles, on the east by the City: of Fresno and on the west by the Pacific Ocean, as a highway comon carrier. In addition this carrier is engaged in the transportation of property between points in california pursuant to permits issued by this Commission under File T-67,163.

By this application, Smith Transportation Co. seeks to exclude from its certificate transportation of the following comodity:
"Chicoite, see Note, in bags or boxes; truckload.
NOTE: Applies only on a natural earth product
containing not less than 73 percent silica ane
not more than 10 percent alumina, having value
for its absorptive properties." National Motor
Freight Classification 100-E, Item 48115.
Applicant desires to transport this commodity under its highway permit carrier authority as a highway contract carrier, for Excel-Mineral Company of Santa Earbara, at rates which will deviate from the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2.

After consideration the Commission finds that the public convenience and necessity no longer requires the services of the applicant for the transportation of the aforementioned commodity as a highway common carrier, and concludes that the application should be granted; however, such conclusion should not be construed as a policy determination with respect to future petitions to exempt certain commodities from the provisions of a certificated operating authority. The effective date of the order should be the date on which it is signed since there is no reason to delay granting the relief requested. A public hearing is not necessary.
ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Appendix A of Decision 84212 dated March 18, 1975, in Application 54362, is hereby amended by substituting First Revised Page 3 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, instead of Original Page 3.
2. Within sixty (60) days after the effective date hereof and on not less than five (5) days notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall amend its tariff on file with the Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.
