ORDER CORRECTING CLERICAL ERROR

It has come to the Commission's attention that the charge specified in Reference Number 8 in Item 311 of Minimum Rate Tariff 15 (MRT 15) should be \$7.65 and the rates for "Van" were omitted in Item 453 of MRT 15 when the surcharges were incorporated directly into the rates by Decision 89358.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Minimum Rate Tariff 15 (Appendix D of Decision No. 65072, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective November 5, 1978, Eighteenth Revised Page 20 and Tenth Revised Page 24-D, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 2. Tariff publications of common carriers shall be made effective not earlier than November 5, 1978 on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public.
- 3. In all other respects, Decision 89358, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

NOTE 1.--Rates apply according to the type of carrier's motor power equipment in combination with the trailing equipment as described.

NOTE 2.--Except as otherwise provided, rates are limited to 8 hours service out of 9 consecutive hours per day. Rate Basis "A" rates are further limited to service performed between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:15 p.m. For operations in excess of these limitations, add rates provided in Item 530.

NOTE 3.--An additional charge of \$13.85 per month shall be made for each unit of carrier's equipment that is equipped with a power-lift gate.

NOTE 4.--In the event that furniture pads or skins are furnished, an additional monthly charge of \$2.95\$ per dozen shall be made.

NOTE 5 .-- Rates do not include temperature control service. When such service is performed, add rates provided in Item 560.
