THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

It has come to the Commission's attention that Decision 89355 does not reflect the intent of said decision with respect to the incorporation of the surcharges in connection with Items 150, 179-2, 330.6, 502, 508.1, 530, 892.2, 892.3, 893 and 895.3.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Minimum Rate Tariff 2 (Appendix D to Decision 31606, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective November 5, 1978, the revised pages contained in Appendix A, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 2. Tariff publications of common carriers shall be made effective not earlier than November 5, 1978 on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public.
- 3. In all other respects Decision 89355, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
