ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Respondent Walter H. Wilson, dba Walt Wilson Trucking, was ordered by D.87751 to pay undercharge and punitive fines totaling \$13,172.95 by August 23, 1977. Said decision was stayed as a result of Wilson's Petition for Writ of Review to the Supreme Court. Said Petition was denied. By D.89050 we terminated the stay of D.87751. Said undercharge and punitive fines became due and payable on August 6, 1978. Wilson has requested that due to financial hardships he be permitted to pay the fines in four monthly installments. He remitted \$3,250.00 with his request.

Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that Walter H. Wilson and Glendora M. Wilson, dba Walt Wilson Trucking, pay the undercharge

and punitive fines in the amount of \$13,172.95, plus interest in four monthly installments beginning with August 6, 1978.
