THIRD INTERIM OPINION AND  
ORDER EXTENDING EXPIRATION DATE

By Decision No. 86908 dated February 1, 1977, the subject application was granted on an interim basis to expire on February 1, 1978. The post-hearing decision has not yet been made, and applicant has requested that an extension of the interim expiration date be granted.
