SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

It has come to the Commission's attention that inadvertently in Decision 88848 dated June 24, 1978 in this proceeding, Item 340, as amended, of Minimum Rate Tariff 2 (MRT 2) did not reflect the full intent of said decision. Item 340 provides for truckload commodity rates for straight or mixed shipments of drugs, medicines and named related commodities.

Further, the Commission in Decision 89355 dated September 6, 1978 transferred certain provisions of Item 340 to Item 840 of MRT 2. This order will provide for the amending of Item 340 and Item 840 to correct the inadvertent omission of a named related commodity in both decisions.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff 2 (Appendix D to Decision 31606, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective thirty-nine days after the date hereof, Fifty-ninth Revised Page 9, Third Revised Page 37-B-1 and First Revised Page 66-N-14 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. Tariff publications of common carriers shall be made effective not earlier than thirty-nine days after the date hereof on one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

3. In all other respects, Decision 31606, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
