ORDER DISCONTINUING PROCEEDINGS

Decision No. 85014 in Cases Nos. 8039 and 9974 was an Interim Opinion which dealt with an emergency situation involving Smithson Springs Water Company. In the order the Commission retained jurisdiction to issue any additional orders necessary for the disposition of the two cases.

The Commission takes official notice that on August 8, 1978, it issued Decision No. 89191, which authorized Smithson Springs Water Company to sell and transfer its assets to the County of San Bernardino County Service Area No. 70 and to be relieved of its obligations to provide service as a public utility water

corporation. In the circumstances the Commission finds and concludes that Cases Nos. 8039 and 9974 should be discontinued.

IT IS ORDERED that the complaint in Case No. 8039 and the investigation instituted on the Commission's own motion in Case No. 9974 are discontinued.
