ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By his application, as amended, Clifford Wilson, doing business as C. W. Transportation Company, requests authority pursuant to Section 3666 of the Public Utilities Code to deviate from the minimum rates for the transportation of boxes, fiberboard paper, or pulpboard for Menasha Corporation.

Following public hearing before Administrative Law Judge Daly at Los Angeles on May 10, 1978, the matter was continued to a date to be set and was subsequently reset for October 19, 1978.

At the commencement of the continued hearing, applicant's representative indicated that further studies would have to be made and, thereupon, made a motion that the instant application be dismissed without prejudice.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 57644 is dismissed without prejudice.

The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the date hereof.
