ORDER MODIFYING DECISION NO. 89069
AND DENYING REHEARING

Greyhound Lines, Inc. has filed a petition for rehearing of Decision No. 89069. The Commission has considered each and every allegation contained therein and is of the opinion that the petition is premature since the Commission has not granted Stuart Alan Messnick, dba The Co-Ordinators, (Messnick), the authority requested in Application No. 55965. The Commission did not determine in Decision No. 39069 that the service proposed by Messnick in Application No. 55965 meets the requirements of Section 206(a)(6) of the Interstate Commerce Act but decided that authority should not be granted unless Messnick can show compliance with Section 206(a)(6) of the Interstate Commerce Act. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the applicant shall have 180 days from the effective date of this order to submit satisfactory notice with the Commission that he has complied with the Interstate Commerce Act.

If the applicant fails to timely submit such notice, Application No. 55965 will stand dismissed as of June 17, 1979.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that rehearing of Decision No. 89069 as herein modified is denied.
