ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On October 20, 1976 Valley Mobile Communications, Inc.  
(Valley) filed Case No. 10194. On June 16, 1977 Valley was  
notified by letter that:

"All cases and applications concerning radiotelephone  
utilities have been temporarily removed from the  
Commission calendar, pending the outcome of Case  
No. 10210 (Commission Order to Institute Investigation  
into the Deregulation of RTU's). You will be promptly  
notified when this matter is again set for hearings."

On August 10, 1978 Valley was notified by letter that:

"The petition for rehearing which challenged this  
Commission's jurisdiction over radiotelephone utilities  
has been denied (Decision No. 89045, dated June 27, 1978  
denying rehearing of Decision No. 88513, in Case  
No. 10210).

"Proceedings which were held in abeyance during the  
pendency of Case No. 10210 are now active and should  
be dismissed or scheduled for hearing.

"Case No. 10194 will have to be amended since it does not  
have sufficient information to satisfy recent changes in  
the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure. (See  
Ordering Paragraph 3 of Decision No. 88513.) Please  
advise whether this application is to be amended or  
dismissed."

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Valley has not replied to the August 10, 1978 letter.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that Case No. 10194 is dismissed for lack of prosecution.

The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the date hereof.
