ORDER TERMINATING INVESTIGATION

Case No. 9879 ordered the institution of an investigation into the status, safety, maintenance, and use of grade crossings over the track of the Southern Pacific Transportation Company at Livorna Road West, Milepost B0-50.94 and at Cervato Drive (B0-50.8), both near Alamo, county of Contra Costa.

It has come to the attention of the Commission that the Interstate Commerce Commission in Docket No. AB-12 (Sub No. 39) dated July 13, 1978 authorized Southern Pacific Transportation Company to abandon part of its branch line which includes the involved crossings and that the part of the branch line authorized to be abandoned has been abandoned. Based on the above information, the Commission staff made a motion to terminate the investigation established by Case No. 9879 since the issues under investigation in the case are made moot by the abandonment.

IT IS ORDERED that the staff motion to terminate the investigation established by Case No. 9879 is granted and Case No. 9879 is terminated.

The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the date hereof.
