SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Decision No. 88882, dated May 31, 1978, ordered respondent Pelco Trucking, Inc. to pay a \$3,500 fine and to remit all undercharges collected to this Commission. The fine has been paid along with \$12,610.74 in undercharges. Respondent has applied herein for an extension of time to take necessary action against several shippers who refuse to acknowledge the debt.

We find and conclude that the requested extension of time should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that the Ordering Paragraph 1 of Decision No. 88882 is modified as follows:

1. The sum of \$7,422.32, which is still owing under the provisions of Ordering Paragraph 2 of Decision No. 88882, shall be paid in full after the Court has issued judgment in the pending collection suits, or upon collection prior to the judgment of the Court, whichever first occurs.
