## SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision \_\_\_\_\_\_\_, entered today in Case 5432, et al., authorized amendment of Minimum Rate Tariffs 1-B, 2, 7-A, 8-A, 9-B, 14-A, 15 and 19 to cover transportation by agricultural carriers. The decision also provided that Minimum Rate Tariff 9-B should be amended by separate order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff 9-B (Appendix A of Decision 67766, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective February 1, 1979, Sixth Revised Title Page and Twentysixth Revised Page 7, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. The rates, charges and rules set forth in Minimum Rate Tariff 9-B are established and approved as the just, reasonable and nondiscriminatory minimum rates and charges to be assessed, charged and collected, and the rules to be observed by all agricultural carriers as defined in the Highway Carriers' Act for the transportation of fresh fruits, nuts, vegetables, logs and unprocessed agricultural commodities in carrier's equipment between the points for which rates are provided in said tariff.

3. In all other respects, Decision 67766, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

4. The Executive Director shall serve a copy of this decision on every common carrier, or such carriers' authorized tariff publishing agents, performing transportation services subject to Minimum Rate Tariff 9-B.

5. The Executive Director shall serve a copy of each of the tariff amendments on each subscriber to Minimum Rate Tariff 9-B.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
