## SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision 89882, entered today in Case 5432 et al., authorized amendment of Minimum Rate Tariffs 1-B, 2, 7-A, 8-A, 9-B, 14-A, 15 and 19 to cover transportation by agricultural carriers. The decision also provided that Minimum Rate Tariff 15 should be amended by separate order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Minimum Rate Tariff 15 (Appendix D of Decision 65072, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective February 1, 1979, Fifth Revised Title Page, and Twentieth Revised Page 4 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 2. The rates, charges and rules set forth in Minimum Rate Tariff 15 are established and approved as the just, reasonable and nondiscriminatory minimum rates and charges to be assessed, charged and collected, and the rules to be observed by all agricultural carriers as defined in the Highway Carriers' Act for the transportation of nuts and unprocessed agricultural commodities in carrier's equipment between the points for which rates are provided in said tariff.
- 3. In all other respects Decision 65072, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

- 4. The Executive Director shall serve a copy of this decision on every common carrier, or such carriers' authorized tariff publishing agents, performing transportation services subject to Minimum Rate Tariff 15.
- 5. The Executive Director shall serve a copy of each of the tariff amendments on each subscriber to Minimum Rate Tariff 15.

## DEFINITION OF TECHNICAL TERMS

AIR MILE means a statute mile measured in a straight line without regard to turrain features or differences in elevation.

BASE OF OPERATIONS means the single point described in the written agreement which shall be a point at which the shipper will regularly tender freight to the carrier or will regularly receive freight from the carrier.

\*\*CARRIER means a radial highway common carrier, a highway contract carrier, an agricultural carrier or a common contract carrier as defined in the Highway Carriers\* Act.

CARRIER'S EQUIPMENT means any motor truck or other self-propolled highway vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, or any combination of such highway vehicles, operated by the carrier.

CHILLED TEMPERATURE CONTROL SERVICE means the service of providing protection against heat and maintaining the commodity at a temperature higher than 32 degrees Fahrenheit.

COMMISSION means the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.

DANGEROUS ARTICLES means articles described in the Hazardous Materials Tariff.

ESCORT SERVICE means the furnishing of pilot cars or vehicles by a carrier as may be required by any government agency to accompany a shipment for highway safety.

PROZEN TEMPERATURE CONTROL SERVICE means the service of providing protection against heat and maintaining the commodity at a temperature of 32 degrees Pahrenheit or lower.

GOVERNING CLASSIFICATION means National Motor Freight Classification NMF 100-E, including supplements thereto or reissues thereof when the provisions of such supplements or reissues have been approved by the Commission.

HAZARDOUS MATERIALS TARIFF means Hazardous Materials Tariff ATA 111-C, Cal PUC 13, of American Trucking Associations, Inc., Agent.

HOLIDAYS means New Year's Day (January 1), Washington's Birthday (the third Monday in Yebruary), Memorial Day (the last Monday in May), Fourth of July, Labor Day (the first Monday in September), Thanksgiving Day, the day after Thanksgiving, December 24 and Christmas Day (December 25). When a holiday falls on a Sunday, the following Munday will be considered as a holiday.

PERMIT SHIPMENT means a shipment which because of its width, length, height, weight or size requires special authority from a governmental agency regulating the use of highways, roads or streets for the transportation of such shipment in whole or in part.

RATE includes charge and also rules governing and the accessorial charges applying in connection therewith.

TEMPERATURE CONTROL SERVICE means the protection from heat by use of ice (either water or solidified carbon dioxide), by mechanical refrigeration or by release of liquefied gases.
