ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision 89683 dated November 28, 1978, in this proceeding, K.K.W. Trucking, Inc., (K.K.W.) a corporation, was granted control pursuant to Section 852 of the Public Utilities Code of a certificate to operate as a public warehouse in Los Angeles. The certificate issued to Firestone Transportation Systems, Inc., a corporation, was also transferred by Decision 89683 from Dennis Firestone, an individual doing business as Firestone Transportation Systems to the corporation. Further, the decision provided for the corporation to issue shares of its common capital stock.

K.K.W. has informed the Commission by letter that due to unforeseen accounting technicalities it was unable to consummate the required transactions in time to comply with the dates set forth in the aforementioned decision. Applicant requests an extension of time permitting it to comply with the conditions of the Order. Since the time for compliance with Decision 89683 is subject to expire prior to consummation of the transactions authorized therein, the effective date of this order should be the date hereof.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant's request is reasonable. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the requested extension of time should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that ordering paragraphs 5 (a) and (b) of Decision 89683 dated November 28, 1978 are amended to provide that applicant shall establish the authorized service and file tariffs, in triplicate, in the Commission's office by July 1, 1979.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
